
FAQs

What is it?

2019 Novel Coronavirus, or 2019-nCoV is a new respiratory virus first identified in Wuhan, Hubei Province, China.



What are the signs & symptoms?



How do I get infected?

Originally emerged from an animal source but now is spreading from personto-person. Transmission is mainly via respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes.





What is the treatment?

There is **no specific antiviral treatment** recommended for 2019-nCoV infection. Treatment is mainly supportive.

How can I protect myself?

- •Wash your hands with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- •Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- •Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue
- •Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- •Cook meat and eggs thoroughly.
- •Avoid unprotected contact with live wild and farm animals.
